Graduated from Waseda University, School of Science and Engineering, Department of Management Systems Engineering.

Koji Fusa began his career in London at a British investment bank and was active in Europe in M&A advisory in the late 1980s. He returned to Japan in 1990, contributing to the development of Japan's M&A and capital markets by introducing innovative financial engineering methods. In 1997, as Head of Investment Banking at SBC Warburg, he achieved the top revenue ranking in Japan among foreign investment banking divisions (Thomson Reuters).

Since 2005, he has focused on venture and alternative investments, specializing in high-tech ventures. He is co-developing electronic medical record systems and remote diagnostics platforms with Professor George Hollander of the Institute of Developmental & Regenerative Medicine. He also serves as Special Strategic Advisor to the Paediatrics Department at Oxford University's Oxford Vaccine Group.

In 2021, he joined the Executive Committee of Ecma-International, a Geneva-based international IT standards organization. From 2021 to 2024, he was Professor at Aston University's Cyber Security Innovation Centre.

In the 2025 issue of *Weekly Toyo Keizai*, GVE was featured as a leading venture company in Japan providing a platform for the digitalization of fiat currency, with a valuation of ¥1.9 trillion, ranking overwhelmingly first in the country.
